Age Dispensation. Dispensations will automatically be given to two players per team who are maximum one year over aged. In classes B16, G11, G13, and G15 teams may use the August 1st age grouping and may use 5 players that are over aged.

Who May Participate? All teams and clubs that associated with their FIFA affiliated national associations are able to participate in the Tivoli Cup. The tournament is played under all applicable FIFA and or Danish Football Association (DBU) rules.

Insurance. All players, staff, and participants must carry their own insurance. The Tivoli Cup, nor United Soccer Academy does not carry any group insurance, and is not responsible for, protecting participants in case of injury, illness, theft or damage to property.

Referees. Referees are appointed by Fredericksborg Referees' Association. Linesmen will be provided for playoffs and finals. Teams must provide their own linesman for group/bracket play.

Playoffs. Teams that place 1st in group play will advance to the next rounds. All other teams will play in the Wiibroe Cup (consolation playoffs).

Program/Tour. Combining participation in the Tivoli Cup with other locations in Scandinavia and or Germany is ideal. For example, combine participation in the Tivoli Cup with participation in the Gothia Cup.

Monday, July 6: Morning arrival in Copenhagen. Evening (7:30 pm) Opening Ceremony.

Tuesday, July 7: Participation in the Tivoli Cup. Sightseeing and tournament activities.

Wednesday, July 8: Participation in the Tivoli Cup. Sightseeing and tournament activities.

Thursday, July 9: Participation in the Tivoli Cup and Wiibroe Cup. A-B playoff matches. Sightseeing and tournament activities.

Friday, July 10: Participation in the Tivoli Cup and Wiibroe Cup - Finals. Sightseeing and tournament activities.

Saturday, July 11: Continuation of the soccer tour in Scandinavia or Germany. Or participate in a second tournament, like the Gothia Cup in Sweden.
